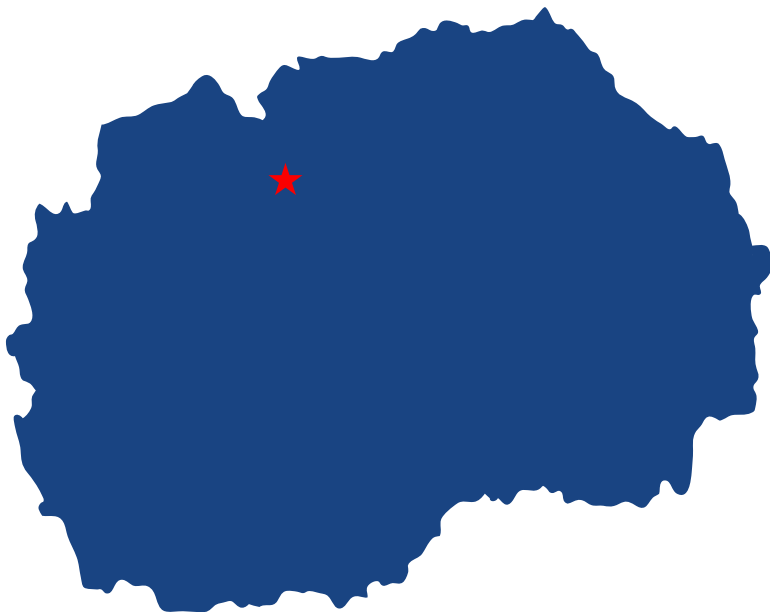


## WHAT IS IT?

Our Foreign National Student Internship Program (FNSIP) is designed to provide foreign national students a unique opportunity to work at the U.S. Embassy in Skopje, gain meaningful work experience, and valuable mentorship from the local staff and the U.S. diplomats.

## PROGRAM DURATION:

**Ten consecutive weeks, from July to September 2024.**



## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Be at **least 18 years old**.
- **Be a citizen or permanent legal resident** of 
- Student is an individual who is **enrolled not less than half-time** in a high school, trade school, technical or vocational institute, junior college, college, university or other accredited educational institution.
- Maintain **good academic standing** at their present institution of higher education and be able to provide a certified transcript.

- Official authorization from the educational institution to take part in the 2024 Summer FNSIP.
- Proof of citizenship/residency permit (copy of residency permit or citizenship or passport or ID).
