

The Kvinna till Kvinna Foundation together with the Institute of Social Sciences and Humanities, Skopje (ISSHS) we are currently implementing the comprehensive training programmme for young professionals in Western Balkans "Gender Equality Education for Practitioners, From Theory to Policy Implementation". The programme is funded by the Swedish Institute as a part of SI Academy for Young Professionals (SAYP).

People that could apply for this programme should:

- be a citizen of and currently working in one of the following countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia or Serbia.
- be command of the English language is required to a degree that enables you to follow a program that combines academic and practical knowledges, so you are invited to assess your proficiency in the language accordingly.
- have a relevant higher education (at least three years)
- be 40 years or younger (born 1984–1999)
- be employed in one of the following groups:
 - Policymakers (politicians, government officials, employees of political parties)
 - Public servants (non-political civil servants working at public organisations)
 - Civil society workers (CSO/NGO employees)

The application period is open 13 March – 10 April, 2024.
